- **Kandaka is a young black woman**
- **The other women cannot always see Kandaka**
- **Kandaka sings and dances**



● **Kandaka guides Claire, Karen and Jacqui through the feelings of mid life**



- The women feel very anxious



- The women feel menopause symptoms



- The women feel rage



● They share how they feel about sex



- The women feel loss and grief



- The women remember things that make them happy



- All the women start to disco dance



- The disco music is loud
- The audience joins in dancing
